Speaking of love, you have been blessing so many people by the gifts you've given. Don't ever take that for granted. I want you to reflect on this verse: "To whom much is given, much is required." I want you to think of this verse as it pertains to your giving. Here are a few questions I challenge myself with that I want you to reflect on for your own personal relationship with God as it pertains to giving.

- 1) If I were God and he were me, would I be pleased with the effort shown giving back to me in comparison to what I have given you?
- 2) If I freely gave to God with gratefulness and trust, would the amount that I'm giving change or remain the same?
- 3) If God gives consistently to me, is my giving reflecting that same pattern?
- 4) My church consistently prays for me, is available, helps its members, blesses the community, and so much more. Am I being as consistent with giving to my church as my church is consistent in giving to me? If not, what can I do to change that?

Only you can answer those questions from your heart. As you're answering them, here is how you can make a difference in your giving through the end of 2021.

- 1) Give to help your church raise 140,000 which will help us (a. bless over 10,000 people, 37 apartments in DeSoto for Thanksgiving (b. help us feed other individuals along with our church family on Sunday, Nov. 21 for our Thanksgiving dinner right after service (c. help purchase the parking lot we've already raised \$10,000 dollars for and need another estimated 60,000 plus to close the deal.
- 2) You can do all of that simply by going to the givelify tab on our giving app and click Make a Difference. Of course, you can continue to be consistent or begin to be consistent in weekly giving.
- 3) I'm only asking you to remember the verse: "To whom much is given, much is required," and then look at what you have and see if you are doing what is required based on what you've been given. That's different for everyone. Everyone has something, but everyone has responsibility for the something they have. I challenge to at least do what God has required of you. You and He alone know what that is. I'm rooting for you to be blessed beyond measure when you do!
